His latest series of children and youth novels; Alpha City 2050 and Alpha City 2050: Rage of the Clones are published by Apogee Books Science Fiction.

With this ongoing series of novels, three trilogies in total, James has attracted the attention of the NIE (Newspaper In Education) program and Metroland Inc.

Launching October 5<sup>th</sup> 2009 James's has rewritten his first book and series namesake for syndication in a serialized format appearing twice weekly in newspapers including the Hamilton Spectator. Illustrated by art students from Sir John A. Mac Donald School its no surprise that James has received rave reviews and support from the education market and is "Recommended Reading" by many Board of Educations. His new book series, both book one and two are being read in many hundreds of schools across Canada and by thousands of educators.

The Foster Parent Association of Ontario (FPSO) is benefactor with sales of the series providing bursaries to youth seeking higher education and attendance at both college and universities across the

country and abroad.

CG Publishing, the parent company has recently taken aim at the broader US and European markets with Alpha City 2050: the series of which there will be nine novels. James third and fourth books tentatively titled Relativity and Foundation: Genesis will be published in 2010.
