#### Conference

- PFSO is working on plans for conference 2020, we are confirming presenters, planning the conference budget and seeking affordable location options.
- FPSO has evaluated the suggestions for conference facilities that were to be submitted by November 30. The board only received two recommendations One was too far outside3 of the desired conference location area, and the other one was not in FPSO's budget for this year. The board will continue to seek ideal location options.

# Charitable status

- PPSO received a follow up from Service Ontario (where the Guardians and Trustees Office sent the letters of Patent FPSO changed with the support of all of your votes back in July. These changers had to be registered as part of the final stages of the reinstatement of the Charitable Status.
- The follow up from the Guardian and Trustees Office and the corporations division of Service Ontario required an update of all of the board members and officers of FPSO. This work was done and submitted back to Service Ontario and confirmed with the Charities Directorate division of the CRA.
- The CRA then requested a full T3010 to be filled out based on the 2018 financials. This is in process and will be completed and returned in early February.
