Additionally work has begun regarding building bridges with the new native CAS; with a goal of unifying all foster parents in the province. Work has also moved forward regarding FPSO's invitation to membership for the foster parents in the private sector.

The Officers of FPSO have also actively pursued the per diem amounts, reimbursable amounts and mileage rates from each FPA/FFA member to fill out the "GRID" information. We believe this information will be instrumental to all of the local area foster parent associations who will be approaching their CAS for rate increases.
